Useful information

Travel information: On your arrival to Port Elizabeth airport, you will be collected by your professional hunter. Please note that transfers between Port Elizabeth and the hunting lodge are FREE of charge. The drive from the airport to the hunting camp is approximately 2 hours.

Health: The Eastern Cape is Malaria and Bilharzias-free, no vaccinations are needed prior to your safari. We advise you to obtain some sleeping tablets, as they will help get over the jet lag and adjusting to our time difference.

Electricity: The voltage that is used in the Eastern Cape is 220Volts.

Currency: The currency is South African is measured in Rand (R) and cents (c). There are 100 cents in a rand.

Credit Cards and Traveller's Cheques: Most international credit cards and travellers cheques are accepted at formal businesses. We accept VISA and Master Card. A 2% fee is added to all Credit Card transactions.

Water: The water is safe for consumption but not recommended. We supply bottled water for drinking.

V.A.T: Value added tax is added on most goods and services, in most cases the V.A.T will be included in the price. Collect your receipts for your higher purchases so that you can claim back your V.A.T at any international airport before your departure. All VAT is already included in your quoted price for your safari.

Medical Service: You are advised to take medical insurance before you leave home. Most hospitals have emergencies and casualty wards.

Climate: Depending where your Safari takes place, the interior of the Eastern Cape can reach temperatures of between 5°C and 15°C during the winter and reach temperatures of between 20°C and 35°C during the summer months. The coastal areas of the Eastern Cape differ somewhat to the above mentioned as the temperatures reach between 10°C to 20°C in the winter months. The winter months (April to August) are your ideal hunting months but we do offer hunting the whole year round.

Duration of Safari: We cater for hunts from 3 days to 21 days depending on the number of animals that is sought. The ideal duration is 10 days to ensure you a successful Safari. Your safari will be discussed with you in full detail prior to your arrival.

Weapons: The preferred calibres to bring with you are 7x57 (153gr - 7mm (170gr - 30/06 (180gr) or 300Win Mag. (180gr). This is what we recommend but it does not mean that you are not allowed to use any other calibre, everybody has his own personal preference. Because of the terrain which is mostly hunted, your shooting distance will range from 100 to 200 meters but it does happen that we can get you closer depending on the conditions. We also recommend that you bring about fifty rounds per calibre for your Safari.

You will also get the opportunity to sight in your rifle on a range prior to the Safari. This is always recommended after a weapon has been transported for long distances.

Suitable rifle ranges with solid shooting benches are available. Prior to your departure from home be sure to practice with your chosen firearms so you are at ease with their features and operation.

We suggest your plains game rifle to be sighted in two to two and a half inches high at one hundred yards - this will in effect enable you to comfortably take shots out to two hundred and fifty yards without having to compensate for distance. A scope is also highly recommended for typical Eastern Cape conditions. (i.e. 3-9x42).

Our professional hunters are skilled, ethical sportsman who will ensure that you look back on your safari, and the manner in which each trophy was taken, with pride. To us, not only the trophy, but the entire experience, is paramount. Our concessions are regarded as the finest hunting blocks in Southern Africa. When hunting with KMG Hunting Safaris, we place the emphasis on the thrill of the chase. On your return home, we want the memories of the sights, sounds, people, smells and the atmosphere of Africa to haunt you until you return.

Hunting plays a major role in our conservation efforts in Africa - to this end the manner in which we hunt, the animals we select as trophies and the ethical professional image we portray as hunters, will ensure that hunting always remains a critical factor in the conservation of our game.

We will do our utmost to select top quality trophy specimens for you, which will be hunted in fair chase. To do this, you will be required at times to walk fair distances, endure heat, thirst and cold, and after all this, make a good clean shot. It is essential that you practice with your firearms prior to your arrival in Africa. Go ahead, use the bench at your shooting range to sight in your rifle, but also practice sitting, prone and offhand shots.

Hunting gear (Checklist):

- 2x Camouflage or Green/Brown Shirts and Pants (Trousers)
- Camouflage hunting cap or Hat
- Durable and well worn-in hunting boots
- 2x Thick socks
- Binoculars (8X30 to 10X40)
- Hunting rifle
- Ammunition (40 Rounds)
- Ammunition belt or pouch
- Casual Clothing - One outfit for use prior and after your safari
- Camera, flash and film - very important
- Video Camera - 220 to 110 volt converter (for video camera etc)
- Any medical prescriptions
- Shaving and cosmetic kit
- Sun protection lotion and sunglasses
- Raincoat or waterproof jacket



Please Note: Take into consideration that laundry is done on a daily basis when packing for your Safari.

Shots and Vaccines: Shots and precautions are necessary almost everywhere you travel outside of the United States (if you originate from the States). Depending on the area that you are travelling to, different precautions must be taken. The areas that we hunt in South Africa are malaria and yellow fever free. These areas normally require you to be current on your M.M.R., and Tetanus. We also recommend Hepatitis series as well.

Travel information: Many people consider Africa a dangerous place to travel. Most of the "problem areas" are located in central and Northern Africa with almost all of Southern Africa being very stable and safe. You are met at the airport and transported to the hunting lodge and you will be with a Professional Hunter at all times during your safari.

hunting the eastern cape

Hunting the Eastern Cape

KMG Hunting Safaris are for hunters by hunters. From your time of arrival, you will be treated to a hunting experience that you will remember for the rest of your life. Our passion for hunting, ethics, professionalism and honesty allows us to assure you that the effort put into your visit, exceed all expectations and beyond.

We offer both plains game and dangerous game hunts and our main operational area is the Eastern Cape province of South Africa. We also offer hunts in other provinces, as well as neighbouring countries when it comes to specialised species.

The Eastern Cape offers a huge diversity in terrain, also the very reason why so many hunters choose it as their hunting destination. Due to this diversity, it offers the province the ability to sustain over 30 different hunt-able species. The Eastern Cape's terrain fluctuates from mountainous thickets to grass plains in a matter of a few hundred yards and boasts an abundance of game. As we strive to hunt each species in their natural habitat, it is sometimes required to travel short distances to these areas in pursuit of these species.

From the mountains, where the elusive grey ghost of Africa, the Kudu Bull moves ever so carefully, to the open plains where the graceful gazelles, the Springbok feeds, the Eastern Cape has it all. One of the main attractions that make the Eastern Cape the desired choice for hunting is the fact that it is Malaria and Bilharzias-free. The climate in the Eastern Cape is quite comfortable. In the winter during the months of April-August temperatures range from 7 degrees Celsius (44.6 degrees Fahrenheit) to 20 degrees Celsius (68 degrees Fahrenheit) and 26 degrees Celsius (77.8 degrees Fahrenheit), this is ideal hunting conditions. The climate rarely reaches extremes except perhaps in the height of the Karoo summer. Its nature depends not so much upon how it changes, but how much you move across the province's expanse and into and out of different climatologically zones. The months from mid April to end July are generally viewed upon as the best hunting months, since it is during this time that most of our animals are in the rut.

Method of Hunting

The method of hunting that we use very successfully is known as spot and stalk. Here, we drive through the terrain to certain lookout spots. These vantage points allow us to get an eagle-eye view of the area in our pursuit to spot animal herds or lone mature, trophy animals. Once a mature animal has been identified, the hunter with his guide will pursue the target animal by foot. The terrain and vegetation in the Eastern Cape, allows for hunters to get an excellent view across valleys, using the shade in the early mornings or late afternoons to mask their movement on the opposite mountain face. Once the distance has been narrowed to an acceptable range, the hunter will get comfortable on the shooting sticks and take the shot in his own time upon the animal presenting a clear and unhurried shot.
