FREE STATE PROVINCE HUNTING SEASON FOR THE YEAR 2008

Species of Ordinary Game	Period during which hunting may take place and bag limits for birds and water fowl
Bontebok, Blesbok, Blue Wildebeest, Bushbuck, Gemsbok, Giraffe, Red Hartebeest, Impala, Common Reedbuck, Zebra (Burchell's and Hartmann), Waterbuck, African Buffalo, Springbuck, Black Wildebeest, Kudu and Eland	1 May 2008 up and including 30 September 2008 1 January 2008 up to and including 31 December 2008 if farm has been registered with an adequate fencing certificate according to the Game Theft Act, 1991 (Act No 105 of 1991) Eland may only be hunted in the Kestell district if the farmer has an adequate fencing certificate.
Common Duiker, Mountain Reedbuck, Steenbok, Cape Hare and Shrub Hare	1 May 2008 up to and including 30 September 2008. Cape Hare and Shrub Hare will have a joint bag limit of (3) three hares per hunter per day.
Helmeted Guinea Fowl, Swainson's Francolin, Red-knobbed Coot Grey-winged Francolin, Orange River Francolin, Common Quail Egyptian Goose, Yellow-billed Duck, Red-billed Teal, Spur-winged Goose	1 May 2008 up to and including 31 August 2008 A maximum total of 10 (ten) terrestrial game birds and 10 (ten) water fowl per hunter per day. All game birds, except Common Quail, may be hunted if in groups of three or more birds.
Klipspringer and Grey Rhebuck	1 May 2008 up to and including 30 September 2008. Animals may only be hunted on farms that have valid adequate fencing certificates according to the Game Theft Act, 1991 (Act No 105 of 1991)
